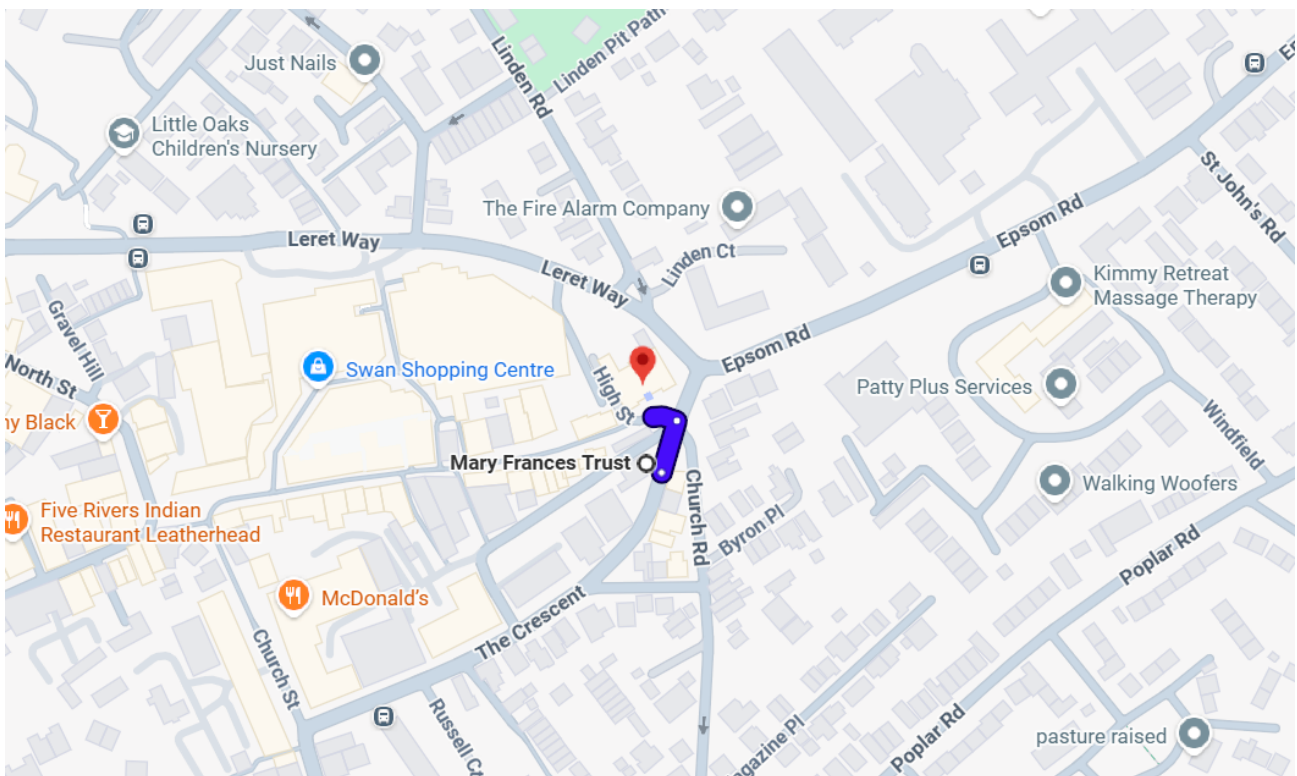

Parking at The Leatherhead Institute

There is no parking available at the Leatherhead Institute. The Mary Frances Trust office carpark is reserved for the staff team organising

the AGM and is not available to guests, clients, volunteers or other staff members that day.

Disabled parking at The Leatherhead Institute

There are two disabled bays at the front of The Leatherhead Institute but these are also for the local community and work on a first come first serve basis.

Alternatively, we can try to book a reserved space at the back of the building. If you'd like to do this please contact Emma by email: emmal@maryfrancestrust.org.uk as soon as possible (not less than 48 hours in advance of the AGM) and we will try our best to reserve a spot for you.

Alternative parking locations

The nearest carpark is [The Swan Centre, 2 Leret Way, Leatherhead KT22 8AH](#). You will need to pay for parking but you can claim this back (see more details on expenses at the bottom of this document). Parking here can be paid via the car park payment machines (both cash and card payments are accepted at these) or by using RingGo (location number 5647). Spaces here have a maximum stay time of 4 hours. Blue badge parking is free here and there are 22 spaces available.

Alternatively, the Church Hall carpark is nearby (about a 5 minute walk) at - [32 Church Rd, Leatherhead KT22 8BD](#). You can also pay with RingGo here as well as with coins and cards. Blue badge parking is free.

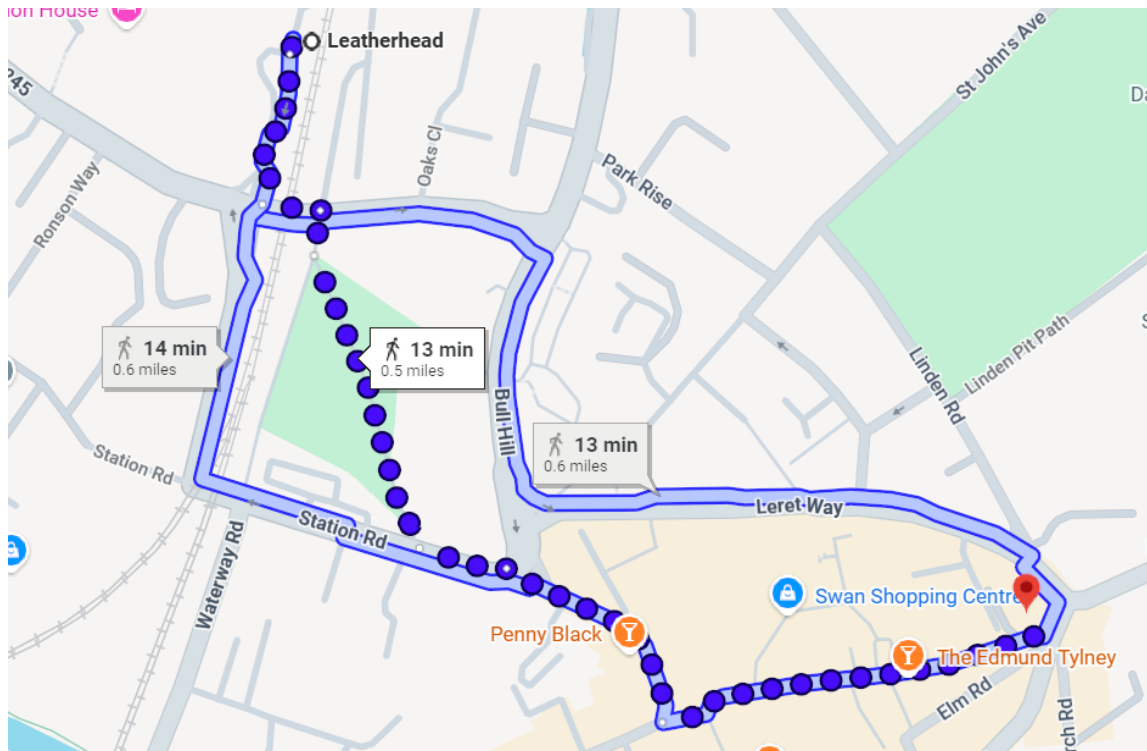
